Lacey Firefighters Join Carnival For Local Kids

South Sound Reading Foundation and Lacey Presbyterian Church Helps Kids in Local Neighborhoods

The Fire Fighters from Lacey Fire District 3 are joining with the South Sound Reading Foundation at three local carnivals this week for four local neighborhoods.

Firefighters will bring a fire truck for tours for the children, amidst the activities at the carnival.

“We do this at all the local events, especially over the summer”, said Lieutenant Alex Christiansen. “The kids just light up when they get to see how a fire truck works. They love checking out the gear and sitting in the driver’s seat!”

Lacey Fire District 3 has five stations, covering 70 square miles and a growing population of 79,450 residents. In addition to fire, emergency and rescue services, the Lacey Fire District 3 Operations Division provides a wide range of fire-related services to the community. Additional services provided by Lacey Fire District 3 include regular code compliance inspections, community safety education to hundreds of school children, station tours, and maintenance of apparatus, equipment and facilities.

The South Sound Reading Foundation aims to ensure that every child is read with 20 minutes a day starting at birth. The Foundation does this by educating and reminding families about the importance of reading each day, and by striving to get books to every child and in every home so that every child is read with daily. Each year the Reading Foundation gives away thousands of new and used books to area children.

Volunteers from the South Sound Reading Foundation and Lacey Presbyterian Church Youth Program will pass out books and have games and activities for the children. The carnivals will be held at the following locations and times:
